High Performance Competition – Long Track Speed Skating

High Performance Competitions for Long Track Speed Skating are sanctioned by Speed Skating Canada (SSC). Saskatchewan Speed Skating recognizes SSC sanctioned high performance competition. Qualification criteria for high performance competitions are determined by the SSC HP Committee and reported through the SSC HP Bulletin. SSC HP Bulletins are found on the SSC website.

Table 1 reports the Saskatchewan speed skaters who have qualified for International and National Level Competition in Long Track Speed Skating.

Athletes who have qualified for Canada Cup #1 must inform the SASSA Executive Director by December 18, 2009. Registration forms should be handed in to the SASSA Executive Director with proper payment.

Athletes who have qualified for Canada Cup #2/ Canadian Junior Championships must inform the SASSA Executive Director by January 11, 2010. Registration forms should be handed in to the SASSA Executive Director with proper payment.

Athletes who have qualified for the North American Long Track Championships must inform the SASSA Executive Director by January 11, 2010. Registration forms should be handed in to the SASSA Executive Director with proper payment.

SASSA is not responsible for late registration forms & applicable fees.

The Canada Cup and North American Competitions will recognize Olympic Style Long Track Time standards skated during the 2008/2009 Season and 2009/2010 Season for eligibility. The Sask Cup #2 in Moose Jaw, SK will be the final opportunity in province Saskatchewan, for athletes who wish to compete at the remaining HP Competitions. Only SSC sanctioned Olympic Style races will be recognized for entry. Eligibility time standards for the 2009/2010 season are reported in the SSC HP Bulletin #153.

Saskatchewan Speed Skating will compete at the 2010 Canadian Age Class Long Track Championships (CACLT) in Winnipeg, MB. Speed skaters, who qualify, using Sask Speed Skating development team selection criteria for the CACLT, must notify the SASSA Executive Director and SASSA High Performance Coach in accordance to Saskatchewan Speed Skating Policy 5.1.3.3.A.X . Failure to notify your intent to compete at the 2010 CACLT will result in your replacement by the next ranked speed skater. The 2010 CACLT Team will be formally announced January 29, 2010.

High Performance Competition – Short Track Speed Skating

High Performance Competitions for Short Track Speed Skating are sanctioned by Speed Skating Canada (SSC). Saskatchewan Speed Skating recognizes SSC sanctioned high performance competition. Qualification criteria for high performance competitions are determined by the SSC HP Committee and reported through the SSC HP Bulletin. SSC HP Bulletins are found on the SSC website.

Saskatchewan Speed Skating will compete at the 2010 Canadian Age Class Short Track Championships (CACST) in Campbellton, NB. Details for CACST will be presented in the Saskatchewan Speed Skating High Performance Bulletin #2.

Sask Speed Skating “AAA” Long Track Speed Skating Ranking

The Provincial “AAA” Long Track Speed Skating Team is selected under Saskatchewan Speed Skating Policy 5.1.6.

The Provincial “AAA” Long Track Speed Skating Team selection competitions are defined under Saskatchewan Speed Skating Policy 5.1.3.
