The 2023 **HP Bulletin #10** – is for the Skating year of June 1st, 2023 to May 31st, 2024 only. The results from the 2022-23 season will be used to select this team.

Saskatchewan Development Team (14-15 years old)

Selection Criteria

- Two Personal Best times within 110% (all distances) of fastest Saskatchewan skater in that year within their age class will be used to select the Team for Long and Short Track (Male & Female). *No Provincial Records shall be used.*
- Must be skating In Province.
- There will be a maximum of 16 skaters (ST + LT) on the Development Team.

Suggested competitions

- The Saskatchewan Winter Games, Canadian Youth Short Track & Long Track Championships, In-Province Meets, Alberta Open Long Track, RU Fast Short Track and Can Am (camp & competition).

Financial Support

- Free Registration for the Fast is Fun Camp
- Reduced Camp Fees for the Can Am Camp
- Can purchase a Development Team Skin Suit (At your own cost)
- Out of Province Competition Support. Athletes will receive up to \$400.00 dollars for attending at least two out of Province Competitions.

Saskatchewan Provincial Team (Age 16+)

Selection Criteria

- Must Skate a minimum of one Canada Cup Long Track standard time. (As stated in current year SSC bulletin).
- Skating Short Track Canada Cup standard times. (As stated in current year SSC bulletin. Currently a combination of 500 and 1500 m times).
- Must be skating In Province.
- There will be a maximum of 16 skaters (ST + LT) on the Provincial Team. If necessary, a ranking will be used based off the skaters top four times compared to Canadian Records.

Suggested competitions

- The Canada Winter Games, Western Elite Short Track Circuit, Canada Cups Long & Short Track and Can Am (camp & competition).

- Can purchase a Provincial Team Skin Suit (At your own cost)
